Painting Animals in Watercolor / Beginners with some experience, to Advanced

Learn how to paint Animals in Watercolor (or water mediums). Students are strongly encouraged to find photos that you might like to paint. Some of these photos should be enlarged to 8 x 10 inch size. Stan will have some photos and handouts for students. How to choose a paintable subject, create a strong composition, interesting techniques, improve your color, atmosphere and mood, will be covered. There will be a number of exercises and instructor handouts. Students who already have their own supplies need not purchase new supplies. Students who don't have supplies or want to try watercolor for the first time should note the Stan Miller supply list. Stan will demonstrate and individually visit students throughout the class. All students should come ready to paint. Cost \$90.00

Stan Miller is a member of the American Watercolor Society as well as an award winner with AWS. He has won two national first place awards in the last three years.

Recommended SUPPLIES FOR CLASS 5 - 10 photos or sketches of subjects you are interested in painting.

Watercolor Paper - Arches 140-lb. cold press. two ½ sheets minimum.

Brushes - 1" flat watercolor brush, synthetic or natural bristle. I also recommend a 1/2" flat brush - medium sized (# 8-15) round and a small round (# 5-7). Bring what you have.

Watercolor Palette with a fairly large mixing area. A glass or plastic large white plate would work. (I use the John Pike Palette)

Watercolor paints a strong red (perm rose, alizarin crimson or quin. red), yellow, blue (thalo or prussian) and black (paynes gray). Students who already have colors, you need not purchase new ones. Water container - Should be able to hold at least a pint of water. An inexpensive grocery store Sponge, paper towels. - Masking tape Pencil and eraser (suggest kneaded eraser) sketch paper or scrap watercolor paper Optional - Watercolor Board no bigger then 24" x 30"
